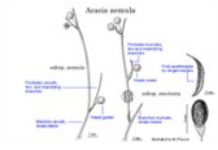

#### Family

Fabaceae

#### Distribution

Disjunct, occurring from Stirling Ra. E to Jerramungup–Ravensthorpe area, with one collection from Scadden (c. 50 km due N of Esperance), W.A.

#### Description

Stems thicker and more prominently ribbed than on the typical subspecies, *muricata*, excrescences sparse on plants E of Jerramungup. Phyllodes *muricate*, subrigid. Flower-heads cream.

#### Habitat

Grows in sand in mallee shrubland.

#### Specimens

W.A.: Scadden, *H.E.Knox 1* (PERTH); Stirling Ra., Chester Pass, *B.R.Maslin 4015* (PERTH).
