# Family

Fabaceae

### Distribution

Disjunct, occurring from Stirling Ra. E to Jerramungup-Ravensthorpe area, with one collection from Scadden (c. 50 km due N of Esperance), W.A.

### Description

Stems thicker and more prominently ribbed than on the typical subspecies, muricate, excrescences sparse on plants E of Jerramungup. Phyllodes muricate, subrigid. Flower-heads cream.

#### Habitat

Grows in sand in mallee shrubland.

#### Specimens

W.A.: Scadden, H.E.Knox 1 (PERTH); Stirling Ra., Chester Pass, B.R.Maslin 4015 (PERTH).
