### Family

Fabaceae

### Distribution

Occurs from near Eneabba S to Mundijong, W.A.

### Description

Terminal **seta** 2-8 mm long; apex of **pinna-rachis** flattened and **recurved**; pinnules (3-) 4-7 (-8) mm long, green to grey-green, hirsutellous to subglabrous. **Calyx** lobes ciliolate and with a few additional very long hairs which are **exserted** in the buds.

### Habitat

Grows in sandy loam, sand, gravel and clay, sometimes in winter wet depressions, in heath and open Jarrah (*Eucalyptus marginata*) or Wandoo (*E. wandoo*) woodland.

W.A.: SE of Eneabba, *E.A.Griffin 3148* (PERTH); Mundijong, *G.J.Keighery 4988* (PERTH); c. 3.4 km E of Muchea turn-off towards Lower Chittering, Great Northern Hwy, *B.R.Maslin 3220A* (B, K, MEL, MO, NY, PERTH); c. 10 km due NW of Dandaragan, *B.R.Maslin 6031* (PERTH).
