

### Family

Fabaceae

### Distribution

Known only from the type locality.

### Description

**Shrub** 0.6–1.2 m high. **Bipinnate leaves persistent** and conspicuous on mature plants; **pinna-rachis** 2–4 cm long; pinnules 7–10 pairs, shallowly concave but often conduplicate when dry, **recurved**,  $\pm$ **glaucous**. Phyllodes 1–3 cm long, 1–1.5 mm wide, flat to **compressed**, thick; **midrib** not prominent. Flower-heads seemingly golden. Pods 5–6 mm wide, with **reticulum** obvious ( $\times 2$  mag.). Seeds transverse, square to **oblong**.

### Habitat

Grows on a laterite ridge in *Eucalyptus* woodland with *Dryandra nobilis*.


