### Family

Fabaceae

### Distribution

Occurs between Caron and Maya and NE of Geraldton. Terete phyllode variants of subsp. *nigripilosa* occur also in the general region of Caron and Maya.

### Description

Phyllodes (1.5–) 2–3.5 cm long, (4–) 5–8 (–10) mm wide, l:w = 3–6, normally dull and **glaucous** to subglaucous, rather abruptly narrowed at apex to **straight**, **±pungent** point.

### Specimens

W.A.: N of Caron, *M.D.Tindale 2777* (CANB *n.v.*, K *n.v.*, L *n.v.*, MEL *n.v.*, NSW, PERTH, US *n.v.*); road to mallee Stn, N of Wandana Nature Reserve, c. 120 km NE of Geraldton, *P.C.Ryan 165* (PERTH).
