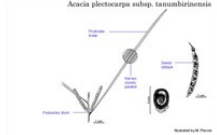

#### Family

Fabaceae

#### Distribution

Predominantly in the southern part of the Gulf of Carpentaria in the N.T. and near Westmoreland, Qld, close to the N.T. border.

#### Description

Phyllodes **linear, straight**, 9.5–19 cm long, 1.5–3.5 (–7) mm wide; nerves with midnerve more prominent than the rest; **pulvinus** 0.8–1.6 mm long. Spikes pale yellow or yellow, 3.5–5 mm wide. **Calyx** 0.5–0.7 mm long. Pods 5–8 mm wide. Seeds **oblique**; **funicle** folded twice.

#### Phenology

Flowers Apr.–July.

#### Habitat

Grows on rocky hills or near watercourses in sandy alluvium.
