Description

Acacia semibinervia is known only from the type and was noted by B.R.Maslin, *Fl. Australia* 11A: 332 (2001) under *A. vestita*. Judging from the type collection this taxon seems to be a garden hybrid involving *A. pravissima* and *A. vestita*. It resembles the hybrids between *A. kettlewelliae* and *A. pravissima* as to phyllode shape and size, gland morphology and inflorescences but differs in its better-developed second longitudinal vein which does not intersect the gland. The *A. boormanii* × *pravissima* hybrids are also similar and differ from *A. semibinervia* in the same way, but in addition, their foliar glands are a little less pronounced.
