#### Family

Fabaceae

#### Distribution

Common in the Mt Lesueur to Moore R. area, W.A.

#### Description

**Shrub** to 0.5 m high. **Branchlets** hirsutellous to **puberulous**, infrequently subglabrous. **Stipules** normally **persistent**. Phyllodes in regular or sometimes irregular whorls, with a few solitary or clustered (2 or 3 per **node**), (4-) 8–19 mm long, 0.8–1.8 mm wide, **glabrous** or nerves  $\pm$ antrorsely **puberulous**. Peduncles 6–13 mm long; heads 22–32-flowered. Pods 5–7 mm wide. Seeds 4.5–5 mm long.

#### Habitat

Grows in sand or lateritic sand, in heath or shrubland.
