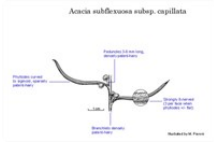

#### Family

Fabaceae

#### Distribution

Known only from a single population S of Cunderdin, W.A.

#### Description

Branchlets densely **puberulous** with **patent** hairs. Phyllodes sparsely to moderately **puberulous** with **patent** hairs. Peduncles 3–6 mm long, densely **puberulous** with **patent** hairs.

#### Habitat

Grows in laterite and sand in scrub.

#### Specimens

W.A.: type locality, Nov. 1982, *B.Smith s.n.* (PERTH).
