#### Family

Fabaceae

#### Distribution

Confined to central Vic.

#### Description

**Shrub** or small **tree** 2–10 m high, usually **erect** or spreading. Branches mostly spreading. Phyllodes disarticulating very easily from stems, 5–10 (–12) mm long, 0.2–0.5 mm wide, **acicular-quadrangular**, rarely flattened, slender, very sharply pointed. Flowers in **cylindrical** spikes.

#### Habitat

Found in woodlands and forests and often riparian.

#### Specimens

Vic.: Lerderderg Gorge, *R.Filson 5053* (MEL); Gordons Bridge, c. 36 km S of Yea, *R.A.Kilgour 61* (CANB); 9.5 km from Noojee towards Powelltown, *E.M.Canning 1370A* (CANB).
